

- Abstract should be in English with a maximum of 1,000 words
- I Use Arial or Times New Roman, 12-point font with single line-spacing
- Abstract must be structured as follows: Objective, Methods, Results, and Conclusions
- One inche (2.5 cm) margin at the top, bottom, right, and left are required in a WORD file
- Provide the title of your paper starting at the top left margin in CAPITAL LETTERS and BOLD font
